Stubben Edge (Risk) Limited (**we**, **us** or **our**) uses cookies and other similar technologies when you visit **our** website <u>www.thewebsite.com</u> (**Site**). **We** use cookies to distinguish you from other users, customise our **Site** and improve your user experience.

1. Use of cookies

Computer cookies are small text files, that are downloaded and stored on your device when you visit a website. These cookies are sent back to a website each time a user requests a new page so it can tailor the experience to that user.

2. How Does Our Site Use Cookies?

Our Site may download and access cookies on your device. **We** use these cookies to improve your user experience and the range of products and services that **we** offer.

Cookies allow you to navigate around **our Site** better and enable **us** to tailor and improve **our Site** by saving your preferences and understanding your use of it. **Our Site** uses the following types of cookies:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are essential for websites to provide basic functions or to access particular features of it. Such features include the ability to sign in, add items to your cart in an online store, or purchase stuff on the internet.

Analytics Cookies

Analytical cookies help us to gather information and are used to determine usage of **our Site**. For example, what features you use and how efficiently you can navigate around it. The information gathered is used to help **us** improve **our Site** and your experience of it.

Functionality Cookies

Functionality cookies are used to enhance the performance of **our Site** as without them certain functions of the **Site** may not be available. However, they are not vital for **our Site** to run, but they do allow **us** to remember important information and user's preferences. Information can include login data, user preferences, language, and enhanced content.

Targeting Cookies

These cookies record your visit to **our Site**, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. Like analytics cookies, these help us to better understand you and, in turn, to make **our Site** and advertising more relevant to your interests. Some information gathered by targeting cookies may be shared with third parties.

Third Party Cookies

Third Party cookies are not generated by the **us** as the **Site** operator but by a third-party using advertisements, targeting pixels or similar. **We** have no control over these cookies. Third party cookies are often used advertising services to serve up customised advertising to you on **our Site**, or by third parties providing analytics services to us (these cookies will work in the same way as analytics cookies described above).

Persistent Cookies

Persistent cookies remain on your device for a fixed period and are activated each time you visit **our Site**. Any of the above types of cookies may be a persistent cookie.

Session Cookies

Session cookies are temporary in nature and only remain on your device from the point at which you visit **our Site** until you close your browser. Session cookies are deleted when you close your browser. Any of the above types of cookies may be a session cookie.

We have carefully chosen the cookies **we** use to ensure that your privacy is protected and respected at all times.
